During this current season they will only have training sessions in accordance with F.A. regulations but I'm sure they will be ready to compete in the League next year.

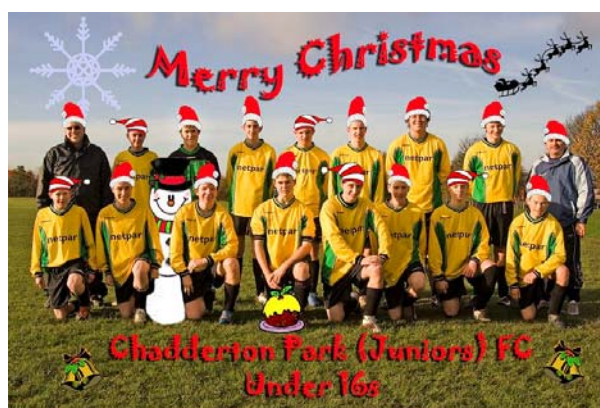
