CHADDERTON PARK FC HOPWOOD HALL WINTER FESTIVAL 2012 RULES

- 1. Children are participating in this festival to have fun and enjoy themselves despite you being cold!!!!**
- Please adhere to the FA Respect Campaign at all times. Thank you.
- Each team may field 7 players from their u8s age group.
- Normal rules of football apply except that there is no offside law in operation and rolling substitutions are allowed on the direction of the referee when the ball is out of play.
- Two sides of each pitch will only be marked by cones. Please assist the referees in determining if the balls are out of play.
- Goal areas will be marked by a cone on each touchline with an imaginary line across the pitch. The goal keeper can pick up the ball anywhere between that line and their goal line.
- A referee will be appointed and his decisions will be final on all aspects of play and the result.
- Games will be 30 mins with a half time interval after 15 mins.
- Injury time will only be played in exceptional circumstances, will be at the discretion of the referee and will be limited to 2 mins each half so that we can keep to kick off times.
- Goalkeepers are able to kick out of their hands at any time including goal kicks.
- Scores will be recorded for administrative purposes only and may be used for determining game 8 playing schedule. They are not for publication or public circulation.
- Any player sent off in a match, for whatever reason, may be suspended from his team's remaining festival games.
- The festival organiser is Mr Mark Rimmer of Chadderton Park FC.

ADMINISTRATION

1. Game fees are £15 per team per week. Please pay with cheque at Pavillion Office on arrival.
2. No player registration is necessary so we therefore trust that no teams will not play any child above under 8s age group.
3. Please ensure you have provided up to date email and mobile telephone number in case we have to contact you to cancel any games. This will be done at the earliest possible opportunity.
4. If any weeks are 'called off' there will be no fee required.
5. Any matches scheduled for a week that is 'called off' will be lost. We will remain with the schedule outlined at the outset of the festival.
6. Details of the last games on the 28th January will be provided on the 28th January if not before.
